Dec 11 Met with Prefeitura Education Dept about continuing and expanding the Improve Your English program for the Belo Horizonte Schools English Teachers, The understanding is that the visiting teachers will pay their own airfare, and there will be a collective effort to raise money to pay for tuition. Colorado chapter may help with scholarship for less affluent teachers, but are not required to pay for tuition. Met with IYE participants from the July 2015 program – except for Juliana Coelho. - The Diamantina Youth Orchestra is very interested in creating a self funded tour to Colorado and select other areas in the US. The MG chapter members are excited about the possibility of expanding the Improve Your English program from only English teachers from the city of Belo Horizonte to including English teachers from throughout the State of Minas Gerais.
